- Primary Care for routine and acute healthcare needs that are not emergencies including: physicals, chronic conditions, illness, injuries, pregnancy tests, screenings, vaccinations, well-child exams, and needs listed under rapid care.
- Rapid Care for minor injuries and illnesses when a primary care provider isn't available soon enough. All patients are seen on a first-come first-served basis without appointments. For needs including mild asthma attacks, possible broken bones, minor burns, congestion or cough, earaches, skin or eye infections, insect bites or rashes, minor cuts and wounds, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, seasonal allergies, sprains, strains, bruises, sinus issues, sore throats, urinary tract infections.

- Emergency For needs including abdominal pain, asthma attack (first or severe), broken bones, severe burns or electric shock, coughing or vomiting blood, difficulty breathing, heart attack, fever in infants under 3 months, migraines (first or worst), poison ingestion, severe diarrhea or dehydration, shock, trauma, serious head injury, stroke, uncontrollable bleeding or amputation.
- Call 911 if someone has the signs of a heart attack or stroke:
 - Stroke signs (BE FAST): Balance issue, Eyes change in vision, Face drooping or uneven, Arm or leg weakness, Speech Difficulty, Time to call 911.
 - Heart Attack signs: Pain/discomfort in chest, lightheadedness, nausea, vomiting, jaw/neck/back pain, discomfort or pain in arm or shoulder, shortness of breath.
